
NUMBER THREE WIND LLC NOTICE OF COMMENCEMENT OF FULL CONSTRUCTION

Number Three Wind LLC (NTW) provides this notice to inform the public that, subject to receiving final approvals from New York State, on or shortly after July 1, 2021, our contractors will begin full construction of the Number Three Wind Project (Project), including construction of twenty-seven (27) wind turbines located in the Towns of Harrisburg and Lowville as shown on the map below. The Project construction laydown yard which was previously installed is located at 8021 Number Three Road, Lowville.

Required equipment will be brought into the Project area using State Routes 812 and 26. Construction will be conducted from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Mondays through Saturdays. Construction will include installation of access roads, turbine foundations and underground collection lines, and erection of turbines.

The NTW Wind Energy Project is a planned 103.9 MW wind farm that will consist of 27 wind turbines, a collection substation, collection lines and an interconnection substation located adjacent to National Grid's 115 kV transmission line at 7181 State Route 812, Lowville. The wind farm was granted a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need by the state in November 2019.
